HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES AND EDUCATION TAKE THE BRUNT OF ARIZONA BUDGET CUTS

December 1, 2009

State agencies have sustained \$1.1 billion in budget cuts since February 2009, with more than 70% of those cuts occurring in health, human services and education. Twenty-six percent of the cuts came from K-12 education, followed by DES (19%) and higher education (18%). AHCCCS's and Health Services' portions were each 5%. Corrections and the balance of state government made up the remaining 27%.
