WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY SERVICES UNIT?

CSU members have knowledge of the resources and services available to assist our diverse community. They can provide answers to questions about the child welfare and juvenile justice system.

WHO ARE THE CSU MEMBERS?

The team consists of Court Mediators, Court Guides, the Families in Need of Services (FINS) division of Juvenile Probation, Child Protective Services, Magellan and the Parent Project®.

WHAT DO THEY PROVIDE?

Information on guardianship, emancipation, dependency, Children's Resource Staffing (CRS), the Parent Project®, mental health and behavioral health services, general court information, answers to frequently asked questions, community-based service referrals and family resolution conferences.

WHERE ARE THEY LOCATED?

Maricopa County has two Juvenile Court Centers with CSU Team members are located at both Centers.
