

Privacy Policy

Normal website usage:

Children's Action Alliance (CAA) has a firm commitment to internet privacy. You can visit most portions of azchildren.org without telling us who you are and without revealing any personal information. The only information we collect from a normal web site visit is the name of your internet service provider, the browser, and the type of machine you are using, the website that referred you to us, the pages you request, and the date and time you request them. We use this information to generate statistics and measure site activity to improve the usefulness of the site to our visitors.

Personal information you choose to provide

In order to participate in the work of Children's Action Alliance, you may choose to provide information. If you do submit information to us, we will use that information for the purposes for which it was submitted. We may also use your information in other ways, such as to contact you about other CAA activities and/or fundraising campaigns.

Sharing of information

CAA does not sell your user information outside the organization. Credit card information will never be shared. However, we may share other information, such as your name and address, with other like-minded organizations to help promote a better quality of life for children and families in Arizona.

By submitting information to us, you agree that CAA may use the information in accordance with this privacy policy. We will update this privacy policy as we deem necessary, so be sure to re-read it from time to time.

Like most websites, azchildren.org may place a “cookie,” or small file, in the browser files of a visitor’s computer. We use cookies to save information you give us so you don’t have to re-enter it each time you visit our site. This allows us to personalize the site to your taste and provide the best web experience possible to our visitors.
